All participants will receive the following:

- Photo and name featured in the Official Program Book
- On-stage appearance during a preliminary competition and the Miss Kansas or Miss Kansas' Teen (MKSTeen) Final Competition. Placement depends on which titleholder the Little Sister is paired with.
- Official badge for the Little Sister and one parent/guardian, granting access to badged events
- Complimentary entry for the Little Sister to the competition show(s) in which she appears
- Parent/guardian tickets must be purchased separately

Participant Information

Participation in the 2026 MKSTeen OR Miss Kansas Little Sister program is open to girls between the ages of 3 and 13, by June 1, 2026.

The child must have successfully completed a preschool program or participated in another structured group activity where they were required to follow directions, adhere to routines, and engage cooperatively with peers. Additionally, MKO reserves the right to determine if a child is unable to continue participating in the program due to noncompliance during rehearsals or activities. For children under the age of five, a parent or guardian must accompany them at all times.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Dress Guidelines

- Solid white or ivory dress (any style or fabric)
- No other colors, heavy petticoats, or long trains
- Minimal clear, silver, or matching sparkles/stones allowed (no fully stoned or sequined dresses)

Shoes

- Must be white, silver, or clear (age-appropriate)
- Shoes must be secure for walking and stairs (no slides, slip-ons, or backless styles)

Rehearsal or Daytime Attire

- Casual attire includes shorts, capris, jeans, casual skirts or dresses, workout wear, etc.

Crown

Must wear the official Little Sister crown and sash only.

Photo Requirement - Deadline May 1, 2026

- Submit one vertical, high-resolution photo (cell phone photos are fine if taken in high resolution—check your settings).
- Photo should reflect age-appropriate clothing, minimal background
- Save file as: SunflowerLastNameSunflowerFirstName.

Tickets & Badges

Each Little Sister and one guardian will receive an official badge. Complimentary entry for the Little Sister to the competition show(s) in which she is featured will be provided with an online access code. Additional information on tickets will be distributed after April 15, 2026.

Housing/Meals

Little Sisters, their families, and friends are responsible for their housing, transportation, and meals during competition week.
